STATE HOUSING BILL A SERIOUS CONCERN — Please act!

State Bill Bypasses Local Review Process for High Density Affordable Housing Projects

Immediate Action Requested. California Governor Jerry Brown is [proposing a bill](#) that strips local governments of discretionary land use approvals for high density projects that include affordable housing. It speeds up the processing of building permits by **eliminating the environmental, design and public review processes for these projects.**

[The City of Vista is strongly opposed](#) to this bill. If passed, it could become law by July 1, 2016, and will seriously impact cities' ability to shape the character and quality of life in its neighborhoods.

VID DRAFT WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN — Your comment requested

The California Urban Water Management Planning Act (Act) included in the California Water Code requires urban water suppliers to prepare an urban water management plan and update them every five years. The Vista Irrigation District is required to prepare and adopt the 2015 Plan by July 1, 2016 and submit it to the California Department of Water Resources by August 1, 2016.



The 2015 Plan provides an evaluation of the existing and planned sources of water necessary to reliably meet demands under normal, single-dry year and multiple-dry year conditions in five-year increments for the 20-year term required by the Act. The 2015 Plan also contains documentation related to the implementation of SBX 7-7 ("20 X 2020" water conservation requirements).

A public hearing on the 2015 Plan is scheduled to be held at the District office located at 1391 Engineer Street in Vista on **June 22, 2016** at 9:00 AM. **Written comments will be received until 9:00 AM on June 22, 2015.** Comments on the 2015 Plan can be made by writing to: Vista Irrigation District, ATTN: Urban Water Management Plan, 1391 Engineer Street, Vista, CA 92081-8840.
