**NEW SPEED INDICATOR SIGNS**

After its third environmental legal defeat, including two lost Appellate Court rulings, the County of San Diego, for the THIRD time, is appealing the latest ruling against it. It appears the County will not back down but will try to financially bleed its opponents to death.

We expect the same treatment. We, too, will not back down. This is our home.
